



Kings Local School District Testing Schedule

In keeping with the Ohio Administrative Code (OAGC 3301-51-15), Kings Local School District offers enrolled students *at least* two opportunities per year to be tested for identification as superior cognitive, specific academic or visual and performing arts gifted.

The identification begins with a parent or guardian completing a gifted referral form (obtained from the child's school or on the Kings website). After completing the forms, the parent signs the form and returns the form to the child's principal. The principal signs the document and sends it to the Office of Gifted Services. The testing is scheduled and the parents will be notified of the testing date. For academic areas, the Gifted Coordinator, Mrs. Carol Robinson, will administer the test. Mrs. Robinson will notify the Office of Gifted Services of the test results and the parents will be notified of the results within 30 days of receiving the test results.

Students who are referred for gifted identification in the areas of visual and/or performing arts will be assessed by the teachers in these areas.

Please notice the testing windows for these areas.

Kings Local School District offers two opportunities for gifted testing:

Fall testing for academic areas— Referrals must be in no later than September 15. Testing will be done throughout the month of October. Mrs. Carol Robinson will assess students in the student's home building during school time.

Spring testing for academic areas —Referrals must be in no later than February 15. Testing will be done throughout the month of March. Mrs. Carol Robinson will assess students in the student's home building during school time.

Visual arts – All referrals must be received by March 1.

In most cases, gifted services for qualified students will begin at the start of the next school year.
