



## Vending Machines and School Stores Standards

(R.C. 3313.811)

The Board of Education recognizes that vending services and school stores provide revenue useful to augment programs within the parameters of the schools. The Board will authorize their use in the District providing that the following conditions are maintained:

- Ensure that products dispensed meet standards set forth by District Wellness Policy (EFG); Food Sale Standard Policy (EFF) and associated Nutrition Standards adopted in accordance to Ohio Senate Bill 210;
- Restrict sales from vending or school stores during meal time as this is prohibited by Federal Law (National School Lunch Program);
- Adhere to policy in handling funds generated from vending and/or school stores as set forth by District Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer;
- Maintain operation of vending and school stores solely by school staff. Students are prohibited from dispensing of monies or making deposits associated with generated sales;

The Superintendent, Manager of School Business Affairs and the District Treasurer/Chief Financial Officer shall develop and implement administrative guidelines which will ensure these conditions are adhered to on a continuing basis.
