New Student Registration

Do you need to enroll a new student in the Kings Local School District? Do you have a child who will start Kindergarten next year? Has your address changed and you need to update your records with the school? Then make an appointment to see Central Registrar Tammy Schnetzer at the Kings Education Center.

When registering a new student please bring the following:

- Proof of residency
- Child's original birth certificate
- Child's social security card
- Custody papers (if applicable)
- Immunization records
- Parent/legal guardian's driver's license

You will also need to meet with Ms. Schnetzer if you have moved to a new address still within the Kings district, so she can update your records. At that time, you will be required to complete a change of address form, show proof of address, sign an affidavit that will be notarized by the registrar to affirm your residency status, and complete a new transportation form.

KJH Nature Trail Ready for Visitors

Shrub after giant shrub of honeysuckle was no match for Kings Junior High students. For the past several years, students in Vonda Fruhwirth's classes have cleared brush and spread fresh mulch to make a nature trail behind Kings Junior High.

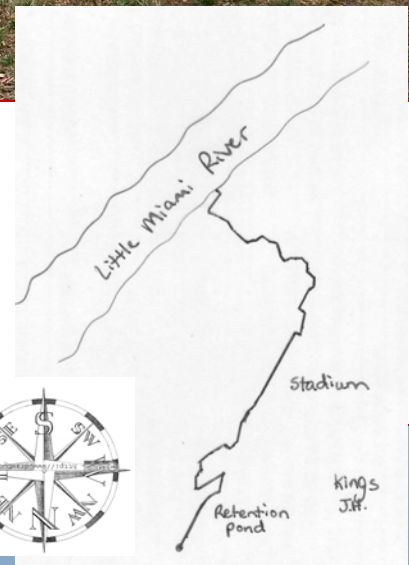
The nature trail begins past the tennis courts and behind the storage buildings (behind KHS/KJH).

Students used a compass, meter tape and graph paper to map the trail from the school the Little Miami River.

To keep with curriculum, there will be markers along the trail to help students identify native plants.

The trail is used for ecological studies: classification, symbiotic relationships—commensalism, mutualism, and parasitism. Mrs. Fruwirth also has a water quality testing partnership with ORSANCO (Ohio River Valley Water Sanitation Commission).

As you walk along the trail take time to notice some of the local inhabitants such as the box tortoise, cardinals or black rat snake. Some of the plants you might see are Larkspur or Toadshade Trillium.
