## District Energy Summit

At the board of education May 18, a proposed budget reduction plan of more than \$1 million was presented. Included in that plan was a \$150,000 deduction from the utilities account. As such, the administrative team at Kings will evaluate a number of initiatives to reduce utility costs for the 2010-11 school year. During the summer, the administrative team will hold an "Energy Summit" to consider options that will reduce energy consumption and Kilowatt demand loads on the district's buildings.

Included in the "Energy Summit" will be:

- Review of a recently completed energy assessment to correct deficiencies
- Determine the need to request certain "Energy Conservation Days" that might call for reduced lighting (rely on day-lighting) levels in buildings to reduce heat loads, particularly during high temperature days
- Establish defined parameters for computers to be shut down on a daily basis
- Evaluate building temperature set-points
- Consider other items brought forth by employees or community members to reduce consumption

### New Student Registration

Do you need to enroll a new student in the Kings Local School District? Do you have a child who will start Kindergarten next year? When registering a new student please bring the following:

- Proof of residency
- Child's original birth certificate
- Child's social security card
- Custody papers (if applicable)
- Immunization records
- Parent/legal guardian's driver's license

You will also need to meet with Mrs. Schnetzer if you have moved to a new address still within the Kings district, so she can update your records. At that time, you will be required to complete a change of address form, show proof of address, sign an affidavit that will be notarized by the registrar to affirm your residency status, and complete a new transportation form.

"You can hardly even hear it running," commented a student when listening to the car after it was started. The goal for electric cars is to hopefully reduce the use of oil in the United States. Electric cars take about 3-4 hours to charge & can drive about 100-150 miles per charge.
