Kings Local School District Names Phil Poggi New Athletic Director

Kings Local School District is pleased to announce that the administration has offered the position of Athletic Director to Phil Poggi, pending board approval on June 21.

Mr. Poggi comes to Kings after working at Aiken High School where he served as Athletic Director and Student Activity Coordinator. Prior to his work at Aiken, Mr. Poggi was Director of Programs for the Marvin Lewis Community Fund. Mr. Poggi is a Kings' alumni, Kings' resident and long time Kings Athletics supporter – even serving on the Athletic Hall of Fame Committee.

"This is where I call home," Mr. Poggi said. "This was the perfect opportunity for me to come back to where I started." Mr. Poggi is a 1994 graduate of Kings High School. From 1996-2002, he worked with the Kings Athletic program in various capacities, starting as an intern and eventually working as an Associate Director of Athletics.

"We are lucky to have found a candidate with such well-rounded experience through his work in the Aiken athletic department, in the business world and with non-profits. We are excited about the opportunities Phil will bring to the Kings High School athletic program," said Kings Superintendent Dr. Valerie Browning.

The district administration searched through more than 70 resumes before narrowing the list to five. Mr. Poggi was a standout during interviews.

Mr. Poggi has lofty goals for the athletic department. He would like to broaden communication with the community and media through social media, community events, and reaching out to the alumni. When he starts work at Kings this summer, Mr. Poggi plans on reacquainting himself with the district's athletic program. After getting to know the athletes and the coaches, he will make plans for how to improve the program and move forward into another great year. Another one of his goals is to partner more with the community and local businesses to help support Kings Athletics.

Mr. Poggi will start working with the district full-time this summer, contingent upon board approval later this month.

Fourth Grade Chorus

After a short delay due to sirens going off and forcing students, their parents and other concert goers into severe weather safe spots within Kings High School, the combined 4th grade chorus of J.F. Burns, Kings Mills, and South Lebanon elementary schools presented a rousing musical performance on the evening of May, 25.

Together, the three choirs performed the songs "Make a Difference," "Americans We, Ahrirang" (a Korean folk song sung in both Korean and English, and featuring several students performing on recorders and percussion instruments), and "He Beeped When He Shoulda Bopped" (a bebop jazz tune featuring a combo consisting of Kings High School students Charlie Fonner on piano and Logan Leahy on bass guitar, plus Kings Local School District music teachers Mike Maegy on drums, and Joe Polen on tenor saxophone).

Additionally, the JFB chorus sang a tune called "Jazz," which featured some wonderful choreography, the South Lebanon Elementary chorus performed the highly-spirited "Dancin' On the Rooftop," and the Kings Mills Elementary chorus presented "Songs of a Starry Night" (a collection of Texas folksongs which featured 4th grader Christina Isbell singing a solo, and 6th grader Kieran Jenkins accompanying the chorus on guitar).
