Kings Student Named US Army Drum Major



Kings Teachers Receive OMLA Grants

The Ohio Middle Level Association has awarded grants to Kings teachers to fund programs. KJH teachers Jen Bicknell and Erik Poggi both

received a 2014 OMLA Mini-Grant. Mr. Poggi said that his 8th Grade White team will use their grant for their RAP Program (Reading as A Pastime), which is an incentive program to get students reading in their spare time. Poggi said, "Thanks to the Ohio Middle Level Association, through the \$500 2014 Mini-Grant For Exemplary Middle Level Projects, we are now able to purchase items for our RAP Auction (live auction paddles, table cloths, table skirts, balloons, and banners) to fulfill the "true-to-life" auctions for our students." Joining Poggi on the 8th grade White Team are teachers Nicole Hindersman, Matt Knott, Sheryl Hoover, and Dave Barta.

Columbia Intermediate School also received a \$500 OMLA Mini-Grant. They plan to use their grant to fund "Funtastic Fridays," an incentive program for 6th grade students, which occurs on Fridays in May if they manage their behavior and assignments successfully. The activities include things like karaoke, bracelet making, Frisbee golf, board games, and puzzles. CIS Principal Shelley Detmer-Bogaert said, "The grant will be used to buy materials and supplies for our Fun Friday's activities. The purpose of the program is to keep very excited 6th graders focused and engaged in school."


Support Kings Women's Soccer
