Solar Eclipse Viewing on August 21

On Monday, August 21, people in North America and parts of South America, Africa, and Europe will be treated to an eclipse of the sun. An eclipse is a path where the moon will completely cover the sun. While many states will get to see a total eclipse, our area will only be able to observe a partial solar eclipse. The last time the contiguous U.S. saw a total eclipse was in 1979.

This celestial event will be seen by our students at Columbia Intermediate, J.F. Burns Elementary, Kings Mills Elementary, Kings Junior High School, and South Lebanon Elementary. Kings High School will also host a viewing party after school on Monday, August 21. Eclipse glasses will be available and special space-themed snacks!

Special NASA approved solar glasses

have been purchased for students' viewing. You never want to look directly at the sun without appropriate eye protection as it could severely damage your eyes. The only time it is safe to view without eye protection is when the sun is completely blocked during the period of a total eclipse, which the State of Ohio will not see.

The local times for the phases of the eclipse is slated to begin at 1:01 p.m. and end by 3:51

Parent/Student Emergency Notification Protocol



The Kings Local School District takes the safety and security of our staff and students very seriously. As a part of an Ohio Revised Code requirement, the District is required to inform students and parents/guardians before the first day of school each year of our emergency parental notification protocols.

In the event of an emergency where an evacuation of the school building is necessary, we have identified off-site locations (reunification sites) to transport students to safety. In emergency situations, we will disseminate information through our All-Call system, as well as use email, text messages, website, and district social media. Additionally, we will continue to provide

updates through the above avenues as needed.

The Kings Local School District believes it is as important for parents to know the resources the district will use in the event of an emergency. It should be noted that an evacuation from any given campus may cause your children to be picked up at a secondary location. If this circumstance occurs, we will utilize a parent reunification form to reunite you with your child.

We will ask parents to be sure that their emergency contact information is up to date in our files in order to be contacted in case of emergency. Feel free to check your account in School Messenger for accuracy, as well.

<u>A Reunification Information Document</u> will be used in the event of an emergency where a reunification process is required. This document will assist us in releasing your child to you at the reunification site. Please take some time to fill out the form and put it in a safe place in your vehicle to be used as necessary.

School Access Protocol



Visitors to any Kings school building are required to show a photo ID when entering a building. The Dis-

trict uses a school security system called LobbyGuard Visitor Management system. LobbyGuard will help protect our students and staff by tracking visitors, volunteers, and vendors who come into our schools.

All visitors will need to sign-in via the LobbyGuard system at the front desk at each building. You will be required to scan your driver license as a part of this process. If you do not have a driver license, another form of valid photo ID is required. A visitor badge will be printed and is to be worn at all times while on school property.

Prior to leaving the building, all visitors must visit the front office and sign-out using the LobbyGuard system. We hope you will find LobbyGuard a welcome addition in the continuing effort to provide the most secure learning environment for our students. We appreciate your understanding.


