#### **Welcome New Staff**

There's been a lot of excitement around the Kings district recently. The teachers have been in their classrooms getting ready for the student's arrival for the first day of school next week. The Curriculum Teams from each school building have held meetings and



many of our staff have attended MAP training, Benchmark Training (our new literacy framework), and Professional Development seminars this summer to be ready for the school year. Additionally, all schools have had their schedule pick-ups and fee pay days. Finally, 42 new staff members have been hired in the district. # Kings Board of Education Approves Levy

The Kings Board of Education passed a second resolution at their August 9 Special Meeting to place a 6.2 mill Operating Levy on the November 9, 2016 ballot. This levy will cost the taxpayer of a \$100,000 home \$217 per year, or \$18 per month. Assuming that the district's funding model stays the same, this levy is expected to last for three years.

The district's last Operating Levy was passed in November 2010. That levy promised tax-payers to last three years. Even with increased expenses, the loss of Tangible Personal Property Tax (TPP), and being flat-funded from the state, the previous levy has lasted six years, three years longer than promised, due to the District's good fiscal practices. The message the District has received from Columbus is that if additional funds are needed to operate our schools, they will have to come from the local community.

#### **New School Access Protocol**

Visitors to any Kings school building will be required to show a photo ID this school year. We are

enhancing our school security by implementing LobbyGuard Visitor Management system. LobbyGuard will help protect our students and staff by tracking visitors, volunteers, and vendors who come into our schools.

All visitors will need to sign-in via the LobbyGuard system at the front desk at each building. You will be required to scan your driver license as a part of this process. If you do not have a driver license, another form of valid photo ID is required. A visitor badge will be printed and is to be worn at all times while on school property.

Prior to leaving the building, all visitors must visit the front office and sign-out using the LobbyGuard system. We hope you will find LobbyGuard a welcome addition in the continuing effort to provide the most secure learning environment for our students. We appreciate your understanding.



# Parent/Student Emergency Notification Protocol

The Kings Local School District takes the safety and security of our staff and students very seriously. As a part of a new Ohio Revised Code requirement, the District is required to inform students and parents/guardians before the first day of school each year of our emergency parental notification protocols.

In the event of an emergency where an evacuation of the school building is necessary, we have identified off-site locations (reunification sites) to transport students

to safety. We will disseminate information through our All-Call system, as well as use email, text messages, website, district mobile app, and district social media. We will continue to provide updates through the above avenues as needed.

The Kings Local School District believes it is as important for parents to know the resources the district will use in the event of an emergency. It should be noted that an evacuation from any given campus may cause your children to be picked up at a secondary location. If this circumstance occurs, we will utilize a parent reunification form to reunite you with your child.

We will ask parents to be sure that their emergency contact information is up to date in our files in order to be contacted in case of emergency.

#### Just a Reminder....

Beginning next school year, there are new immunization requirements for schools in Ohio regarding the meningococcal vaccine. The state will require incoming 7th graders to have one dose of meningococcal vaccine in addition to the requirement of one dose of Tdap vaccine.

Students entering 12th grade will need to have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine. The second dose must be administered on or after the 16th birthday. If the first dose of meningococcal vaccine was administered after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

Meningococcal vaccines help prevent against the bacteria that cause meningococcal disease.

Digital files are required to be 300 ppi resolution and are at least 2.5" x 3.5" in size, submitted without any watermarks or photographer logos.

The last day to submit senior pictures is Tuesday, November 22, 2016. If you don't have a school portrait taken, you will be listed as Not Pictured.






#### KJH Golfer Gets Hole in One




