JFB Teacher Receives Grant

Congratulations to J.F. Burns Elementary First Grade Teacher, Emily Roewer who received a \$2,000 grant from Voya Financial's Unsung Heroes Program. For twenty years, Voya's program has granted funds to K-12 educators who are utilizing new teaching methods and techniques that improve learning.

The grant will fund the purchase of 100 hanging garden planters that first grade students will use to create a vertical



garden along a fence near the existing garden beds at JFB. Students can easily access and maintain the planters, making it a hands on experience from planting to harvesting. "The gardening project will be a perfect example of finding creative solutions by looking for potential in unlikely places and transforming an unused space into something full of life and learning," said Mrs. Roewer. The grant will also fund the purchase of picture books that reinforce this idea of thinking outside the box, combining outdoor learning, literacy, and innovative thinking.

In addition to the \$2,000 award, Mrs. Roewer's project may also be selected to receive an additional \$5,000, \$10,000, or \$25,000 award. She will be notified of the final judging by late September if she is a winner. We will keep you posted! Congratulations, Mrs. Roewer!

Senior Picture Yearbook Guidelines

Many of our seniors are in the process of getting their senior pictures taken. In order to put their picture into the KHS yearbook, there are some guidelines that need to be followed. Photos should be COLOR in portrait orientation and cropped generally to the shoulders and above. Digital files are required to be 300 ppi resolution and are at least $2.5'' \times 3.5''$ in size, submitted without any watermarks or photographer logos.

The last day to submit senior pictures is Tuesday, November 22, 2016. If you don't have a school portrait taken, you will be listed as Not Pictured.

New School Access Protocol

Visitors to any Kings school building will be required to show a photo ID. We are en-

hancing our school security by implementing LobbyGuard Visitor Management system. LobbyGuard will help protect our students and staff by tracking visitors, volunteers, and vendors who come into our schools.

All visitors will need to sign-in via the LobbyGuard system at the front desk at each building. You will be required to scan your driver license as a part of this process. If you do not have a driver license, another form of valid photo ID is required. A visitor badge will be printed and is to be worn at all times while on school property.

Prior to leaving the building, all visitors must visit the front office and sign-out using the LobbyGuard system. We hope you will find LobbyGuard a welcome addition in the continuing effort to provide the most secure learning environment for our students. We appreciate your understanding.



Parent/Student Emergency Notification Protocol

In case you missed this, we are re-posting—The Kings Local School District takes the safety and security of our staff and students very seriously. As a part of an Ohio Revised Code requirement, the District is required to inform students and parents/quardians emergency parental notification protocols.

In the event of an emergency where an evacuation of the school building is necessary, we have identified off-site locations (reunification sites) to transport students

to safety. We will disseminate information through our All-Call system, as well as use email, text messages, website, district mobile app, and district social media. We will continue to provide updates through the above avenues as needed.

The Kings Local School District believes it is as important for parents to know the resources the district will use in the event of an emergency. It should be noted that an evacuation from any given campus may cause your children to be picked up at a secondary location. If this circumstance occurs, we will utilize a parent reunification form to reunite you with your child.

We will ask parents to be sure that their emergency contact information is up to date in our files in order to be contacted in case of emergency.


