Niche K-12 Ranks Kings #7 Best School District in Cincinnati Area

The 2018 Niche K-12 rankings have been released and we are thrilled to report that the Kings Local School District is ranked #7 in the Cincinnati Metro Area, up from #10 last year. Additionally, Kings improved eight places to #30 in all of Ohio!

Niche K-12 offers unique insight into more than 100,000 K-12 schools based on dozens of statistics and millions of reviews from students and parents, as well as data from the U.S. Department of Education. Students and parents can explore millions of reviews and rankings and compare educational outcomes across schools and districts.

The rankings from Niche are a bit different than some of the other school rankings. They believe that the quality of a school or district should be measured, at least in part, by the parents and students who actually go there. They should also be measured by hard data and across a number of key factors so that no one factor dominates a ranking.

There are 608 public school districts in the state of Ohio and the Kings Local School District consistently ranks highly in the state. Additionally, Kings is ranked #239 out of 10,574 districts in America up from #576 last year! All schools in our district have been awarded an overall Niche Grade of an A.



Kings Receives Technology Grant



The Kings Local School District is pleased to announce that we will receive \$33,932.40 through an FCC E-rate technology grant.

E-rate is a Schools and Libraries Program of the Universal Service Fund, which is administered under the direction of the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). The grants provide discounts to assist schools and libraries in the United States to obtain high-speed Internet access and telecommunications at affordable rates. It is funded through a Universal Service fee charged on every phone line.

In 2016 over \$3 billion was distributed to schools and libraries nationally. Superintendent, Tim Ackermann credits Kings Technology Director, Deann Burns and her staff for their work in gathering the data needed to apply for this grant. Burns stated that the grant money was used to upgrade the district's network infrastructure.

Hello, Kings Community.

Welcome back to school! It's going to be another exciting year for the Kings School District. We continue to grow and have seen a large increase in enrollment. We have welcomed over 200 additional students to our district this year. We are excited about the eleven new developments being built within our district. Our enrollment is climbing close to 4,600 and some of our classes have nearly 400 students!

We will continue to look at our enrollment and how that impacts our building capacities. We have a Long Range Facility Committee who is working on a Master Plan and we will be asking the community for feedback in the very near future.

Our summer staff completed several projects throughout the district. KME and CIS received a media center update. We added five new preschool classrooms in the Kings Education Center. JFB received a roof repair and new ice tanks. You should also check out their outdoor classroom rain garden! We added another "21st Century Learning" math classroom at KJH and SLE received a new sign. Lastly, a complete renovation of the Kings High School Media Center was undertaken this summer. The new Learning Commons will be a great space for students and teachers to learn and grow in this 21st Century Learning concept.

As we talk about 21st Century Learning, we have developed a new tagline for our district's #KingsStrong Strategic Plan; Relate. Create. Innovate. Our teachers and staff will focus on fostering positive relationships with our students that will give the students the confidence to create and be innovative which will help them succeed in their future.

Our Board of Education approved a new <u>Wellness Policy</u> for this school year. In addition, a <u>Classroom Snack List</u> was developed to provide guidance to parents in selecting healthy and nut free snacks for the classroom.

We are always looking for ways to grow the district as we strive for excellence year after year. We will continue to research best practices, as well as keeping an eye on district finances and make fiscally responsible decisions. It takes constant effort to maintain quality and I am committed to doing whatever it takes to maintain that for our students!




