


During the holiday, the following items are exempt from sales and use tax: Clothing priced at \$75 per item or less, school supplies priced at \$20 per item or less, and school instructional materials priced at \$20 per item or less.

School Fee Changes for the 2017-2018 School Year

In an effort to be fiscally responsible, the Kings Administration reviewed and analyzed school fees for each grade level for the 2017-2018 school year. The fees were calculated based on the consumable supplies (paper, workbooks, planners) that will be used by each specific grade level. The goal was to ensure that the fees would cover only the supplies that will be used during the school year.

With this review, parents will find that some fees have dropped and some have increased. The district focused on being as financially responsible by negotiating with our vendor base to be sure we were receiving the most competitive pricing, as well as reducing the wastage of resources.

Kings Superintendent, Tim Ackermann said, "The district's school fee structure hasn't been evaluated in 6 years. We will evaluate yearly going forward and will try to keep fees stable and consistent year to year. Our goal is to only charge fees based on the needs of our students."

The Kings School District is committed to providing the highest quality education while continually trying to keep costs down. We thank the Kings Community for their financial support throughout the years.

They are located on the second floor of the Kings Education Center.

KHS Student Places Second at FBLA National Competition

A big Knight congratulations to Kings High School Senior, Spencer Kinkelaar who competed at the 2017 National Leadership Conference of the Future Business Leaders of America, (FBLA) in Anaheim, California June 29-July2. Spencer competed in the category of Securities and Investments and finished in second place out of 125 competitors.

The individuals who competed in this event are the best of the best representing each state in the United States, as well as schools located in Europe,



China, and the Caribbean. The top 1st-3rd place winners from each state were eligible to compete. Participants from across the United States and abroad attended this exciting conference to enhance their business skills, expand their networks, and participate in more than 70 business and business-related competitive events.

Spencer also represented the Ohio Chapter of FBLA during the business meeting, as he is currently serving as the 2017-18 Ohio FBLA Vice-President of External Affairs. He received national recognition at the FBLA Awards of Excellence Program on July 2. The award was part of a comprehensive national competitive events program sponsored by FBLA that recognizes and rewards excellence in a broad range of business and career-related areas.

For many students, the competitive events are the capstone activity of their academic careers. In addition to competitions, students immersed themselves in interactive workshops, visited an information-packed exhibit hall, and heard from motivational speakers on a broad range of business topics.

FBLA is the largest business career student organization in the world. Nationally, the high school division has 215,000 members and Ohio FBLA has about 1,000 members. 
Madame More' said, "As their group leader, I was proud of our students and how well they represented Kings by their behavior, dress code, endurance and compassion, and their speaking French with French natives."


