# Kings Enrollment Larger Than Expected

The Kings Administration has been preparing for an increase in enrollment for a few years now. The company, Decision Insite, was hired to assist Kings in predicting where the growth would occur within the District.



You may remember last school year when we held

Community Enrollment Meetings to address the growing population in the Kings School District. From those meetings, a decision was made to redraw the District boundary lines to help accommodate the new students. Because of the boundary changes, nearly 150 students will move from Kings Mills Elementary to J.F. Burns Elementary this school year.

Decision Insite predicted that in this school year, we could expect nearly 75 new students to enroll in the District. Early enrollment numbers are already showing an increase of over 200 students from last school year, and we are still enrolling new students daily. This year's incoming Kindergarten class has already enrolled 366 students and our largest class so far is our third grade class with 377 students. Based on the numbers, our enrollment will be up over 5% for the 2016-2017 school year.

This increased enrollment has resulted in the need to purchase more materials such as books, educational licenses, and technology, as well as hire new teachers to accommodate the growth. "While the increase in enrollment has come faster than expected, we are incredibly excited about the growth and thrilled that people are investing in Kings Schools," said Tim Ackermann, Kings Superintendent.

Join us for a Special Board of Education Meeting on Tuesday, August 9, 2016 at 5:30 p.m. when our Board will vote on a second Resolution to Proceed, to place a 6.2 mill levy on the November 8, 2016 ballot. Meeting will be held in the Kings Education Center, Conference Room 2.



Early Release WILL be observed on the first day of school, Wednesday, August 17. Students will be dismissed from their respective school building one-hour early every Wednesday throughout the entire school year. Our staff utilizes this time

for professional development.

## KHS Students Place Fifth at FBLA National Competition

Kings High School students Brendan Guerin and Spencer Kinkelaar competed at the 2016 National Leadership Conference of the Future Business Leaders of America. The conference was held June 29-July 2 in Atlanta, Georgia. They competed in the category of Banking and Financial Systems and finished 5th place out of 185 teams of competitors!

More than 9,380 high school student participants from across the United States and abroad attended this exciting conference to enhance their business skills, expand their networks, and participate in more than 65 business and business-related competitive events.



Brendan and Spencer received national recognition at the FBLA Awards of Excellence Program on July 2. The award was part of a comprehensive national competitive events program sponsored by FBLA-PBL that recognizes and rewards excellence in a broad range of business and career-related areas. For many students, the competitive events are the capstone activity of their academic careers. In addition to competitions, students immersed themselves in interactive workshops, visited an information-packed exhibit hall, and heard from motivational speakers on a broad range of business topics.

Spencer and Brenden chartered the Kings chapter of FBLA and were the first Kings students to participate in FBLA. On their journey to the National Competition, they placed in the top-ten in 26 different events at the FBLA Ohio State Leadership Conference. In addition, Spencer was elected to serve at the 2016-2017 State of Ohio Vice President of the Southern Region of FBLA.


FBLA is the largest business career student organization in the world. Nationally, the high school division has 215,000 members and Ohio FBLA has about 1,000 members.

#### Just a Reminder....

Beginning next school year, there are new immunization requirements for schools in Ohio regarding the meningococcal vaccine. The state will require incoming 7th graders to have one dose of meningococcal vaccine in addition to the requirement of one dose of Tdap vaccine.

Students entering 12th grade will need to have a second dose of meningococcal vaccine. The second dose must be administered on or after the 16th birthday. If the first dose of meningococcal vaccine was administered after the 16th birthday, a second dose is not required.

#### **Senior Picture Yearbook Guidelines**

Many of our seniors are in the process of getting their senior pictures taken. In order to put their picture into the KHS yearbook, there are some guidelines that need to be followed. Photos should be COLOR in portrait orientation and cropped generally to the shoulders and above. Digital files are required to be 300 ppi resolution and are at least 2.5" x 3.5" in size, submitted without any watermarks or photographer logos.

The last day to submit senior pictures is Tuesday, November 22, 2016. If you don't have a school portrait taken, you will be listed as Not Pictured.






