

# Health Hero Flu Vaccination Clinic for Students - September 25, 2017





For the health of all of our students, staff, and your family we encourage you to obtain a flu vaccination for your child and your family through your healthcare provider or pediatrician.

It is our pleasure to offer on-site flu vaccinations for students again this year on September 25, 2017. Flu clinics will be offered at each school during school hours.

Health Hero, Inc. will be offering flu shots for our students

with no deductibles or out of pocket expenses. Private insurance companies and Medicaid will be billed. Students with no insurance will be provided their flu vaccine at no cost. Nasal FluMist is not available this year based on CDC recommendations.

The Health Hero Clinic is strictly voluntary. Forms will be sent home with students. You can also download the consent form, completely fill out and sign. Consent forms need to be returned to your child's school by September 15 to secure a dose for your child. No student will receive a vaccine unless a written <u>completed consent form</u> is returned to school.






