


#### **KJH PACT**

Kings Local Schools have instituted a new positive behavioral program in grades K-8 this year. Positive Behavioral Intervention and Supports (PBIS) promotes positive behavior school-wide. This proactive systems approach to improve student behavior and discourage or reduce chal-



A part of the PBIS program is the PACT Program at Kings Junior High. PACT is an acronym which stands for PRIDE, ATTITUDE, COMMITMENT, TOGETHER. It's a positive behavior system that teaches, emphasizes, and reinforces character education.

Since the first day of school, students have learned the meaning of PACT and the importance of strong character. Teams have worked together to define each of the attributes of PACT and

#### Planting Milkweed at JFB

Students in Mrs. Bogard and Mrs. Thomas' 2nd grade classes at J.F. Burns Elementary School were donated milkweed to plant this week. These plants are important to the Monarch butterfly because they provide a place for the eggs to be laid and the food for the caterpillars after they hatch in the Spring.

J.F. Burns' Outdoor Classroom is an official Monarch Waystation. To be certified as such, they had to create a monarch habitat rich with milkweed, nectar sources, and shelter needed to sustain monarch butterflies.

Tomorrow, Saturday, September 10, our Kings Marching Band will host the Kings Invitational, sponsored by the Kings Band Boosters. Eighteen regional bands will compete in 5 classes. 


