



FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS ABOUT MOSQUITO JOE

We know that no more mosquitoes sounds too good to be true so here are answers to our most commonly asked questions about Mosquito Joe.

Q What is Mosquito Joe?

A Mosquito Joe provides mosquito control treatment to residential and commercial customers. Our technicians are trained mosquito control experts dedicated to one thing: getting rid of mosquitoes so that you can enjoy being outside again.

Q How does the barrier spray service work?

A Our main service is a barrier spray treatment, which essentially establishes a barrier to keep mosquitoes out of your yard. A certified technician will walk your property, inspect for mosquito sources and problem areas, and treat them using a backpack sprayer. An individual treatment will last about three weeks or 21 days, after which we will be scheduled to return to treat the yard again. The technician will also perform treatments for areas of standing water, in order to keep the mosquito larvae from developing into blood sucking adults.

Q What chemicals are being used in my yard and are they safe for my plants/pets/kids?

A Our main barrier spray chemicals are synthetic forms of pyrethrins called pyrethroids. Pyrethrins are insecticides that are derived from the extract of chrysanthemum flowers. Pyrethroids are used in numerous commercial products such as household insecticides, pet shampoos and sprays, and even lice shampoos. We spray this chemical on shrubs, low lying trees, your foundation, mulch beds, etc. As it is a plant derivative, it will not harm plants. We also use an all-natural product around ponds, vegetable gardens, flowering shrubs and flowers to keep them safe and not harm our pollinators. All chemicals we use are EPA approved. You, your children and your pets should not be outside during the application of the spray treatment, but you may return to your outdoor fun after allowing 30 minutes for the treatment to dry.

Q there an all-natural treatment option?

A Absolutely. However, our all-natural spray needs to be applied more often to be effective and it repels mosquitoes rather than eliminating them. Prices may differ for this solution.
