The High School

Kings High School is a comprehensive four-year college preparatory high school enrolling 1,400 students, providing 146 course offerings; including 22 AP offerings. By partnering with nearby universities such as the University of Cincinnati and Sinclair Community College, Kings High School is able to offer College Credit Plus courses in Engineering to supplement the rich offerings of Honors and Advanced Placement. Since 2013 *U.S. News & World Report* has listed Kings High School as one of "America's Best High Schools" earning the Silver Award. KHS students lead and learn through community service, 30 school sanctioned extracurricular activities, 26 athletic teams including 6 conference championships and an award winning music department.
