## Graduation Requirement

All students at Kings High School must complete a community service requirement to graduate. Students must complete half of their hours in a non-profit organization recognized as 501(c). All hours must be complete by December 1st of senior year.

Students who transfer to KHS will have their hours pro-rated as follows:

Freshman Transfers - 50 hours

Sophomore Transfers - 35 hours

Senior Transfer - 15 hours

## **Process**

- 2. Upload a picture of yourself to your account.
- 3. When volunteering, take a selfie or picture of yourself doing the work.
