

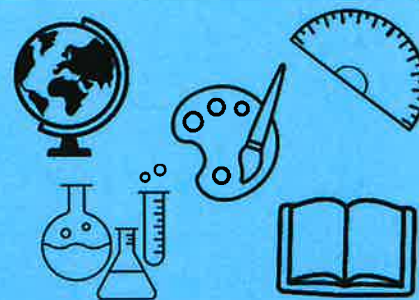
OHIO HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS CLASSES OF 2023 & BEYOND



Cover the Basics:

23 credits are needed for graduation:

- 4 Math credits
- 4 English credits
- 3 Science credits
- 3 Social Studies credits
- 1 Health/Phys. Ed credit
- 1.5 Language, Fine Arts, and/or Technology credit
- 6.5 Elective credits



Show Competency...

- Demonstrate "competency" in Algebra 1 and English II by taking an End of Course (EOC) test and scoring a 684 or better (most students will meet this)

OR

- Demonstrate Career Experience and Technical Skill (if a EOC of 684 is not earned) by
 - earning 12 industry credentials **or** a pre-apprenticeship **AND**
 - The Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal **or** 250 hours of work-based learning

OR

- Demonstrate Military Readiness by enlisting in the armed forces upon graduation

Show Readiness:

By earning 2 State and Local Diploma Seals

Seal Requirements:

Honors Diploma: Earn any of the Academic, Career Tech, STEM, Arts, Social Science & Civic Engagement Seals

Technology: Complete 1 credit hour of an approved tech course or earn a 3 or higher on a related AP exam

OMJ: Meet the requirements for the readiness seal

Citizenship: Earn a 700 or higher on BOTH the US History and Government Exams

Biliteracy: Meet requirements and assessments

College Ready Seal: ACT score with English of 18 or higher, Reading of 22 or higher, and Math of 22 or higher

Industry Recognized Credential: Earn an approved industry-recognized seal

Science: Earn a 700 or higher on the Biology EOC Exam

Military Enlistment: Enlistment in a branch of the armed forces or JROTC

Community Service: All Kings seniors will earn this seal by meeting their community service requirement
