The Community

The Kings Mills/Deerfield Township area of 40,000+ residents continues to grow substantially, attracting college-educated professionals who seek family-friendly neighborhoods in an outstanding school district. The High School

Kings High School is a comprehensive four-year college preparatory high school enrolling 1,450 students, providing 146 course offerings; including 21 AP offerings. By partnering with nearby universities such as the University of Cincinnati and Sinclair Community College, Kings students are able to take College Credit Plus courses in Engineering, English and other subjects to supplement the rich offerings of Honors and Advanced Placement. Since 2013 *U.S. News & World Report* has listed Kings High School as one of "America's Best High Schools". KHS students lead and learn through community service, 30 school sanctioned extracurricular activities, 26 athletic teams including 6 conference championships and an award winning music department.
