Academic Support at KJH

Quest

- Supports students in Language Arts and/or Math
- o Builds skills that will translate into success in other classes
- Students will be placed in Quest based on MAP scores, AIR scores, and teacher recommendation
 - Scores used for placement indicate that students are not on track to pass state assessments, EOC Exams or receive college ready scores on ACT/SAT without intervention
- Mandatory class for those who qualify
 - Qualifying students will receive an email (sent to parents/guardians)
 - Students may be added or removed from Quest in the spring/summer as more data becomes available
- Quest is a one or two-semester class, and will take the place of an encore
 - Students' progress will be tracked and students that meet performance goals will be able to choose an encore to take in its place

Core Academic Courses

- Language Arts (or Accelerated LA)
- Math (or Accelerated 7th Grade Math, or High School Honors Algebra)
- Social Studies
- Science

All courses taken for High School Credit will remain on a student's transcript.

*The only course that fits this criteria in 7th grade is Honors Algebra I

Honors and Accelerated Classes

- Students are placed in advanced classes based on the following information:
 - Common classroom assessments
 - AIR scores
 - MAP scores
 - Grades
 - Teacher Recommendation
- In order to request a change in placement (a placement that was *not* recommended)
 - Contact your CURRENT teacher to discuss next year's placement.

Year Long Encore Classes

- Choir
- Band

- Guided Intervention (students with IEPs)
- Quest (based on scores & teacher recommendation)

Based on District & State data, as well as teacher recommendation, some students will be required to participate in an intervention course. (Quest or Guided Intervention.)

If you are taking Music, you will need <u>2 Semester Encores</u> (or one more Year long encore), and AT LEAST <u>2 Alternate Choices!</u>

- Are there any required classes for 7th grade?
 - 7th Graders must take Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies.
- Is Music a required class?
 - No, there is not a music requirement in 7th Grade.
- Can I rank my Encore choices ensure I am placed in my top choice?
 - No. Ranking encore classes will not guarantee that you get your first Encore choice.
 Sometimes we do not have the space or enough teachers to accommodate everyone's top choice. We do our best to ensure you get at least one of your top four choices.
- Do my course selections guarantee placement in encore classes?
 - No. We will do our very best to get as many students their requests as we possibly can. Sometimes, we simply don't have the space, or enough teachers to accommodate your requests. Sometimes there is a conflict on your schedule that doesn't allow all of your requests to work. It's important to put Alternate choices for encores in case your first choices don't work!

- Am I guaranteed placement in my recommended core classes (Accelerated LA, Accelerated Math)?
 - Yes, you are guaranteed to be place in your recommended core classes.
- My teacher did not recommend me for an accelerated class. Can I still sign up?
 - We think our teachers are experts in their subject area, and are really good in determining if students will be successful in an Accelerated class. If you and your family disagree, you can fill out a 'Course Placement Change' form. Please contact your current teacher to discuss this, and get a copy of the form.
- Can I change my mind about the classes I am taking?
 - We build our Master Schedule based on what students choose on their Course Selection Sheets. This means that we decide how many of each class is needed based on what you choose. If you change your mind, there might not be room available in the class you want since we didn't plan on you being there.

- Can I choose the order of my classes?
 - No. Your requests are all put into our scheduling program, and it decides the order of classes for each student that allows the most people to have their requests.
- My friend/neighbor/sister says I should have a specific team. Can I request a specific team?
 - No. All of our 7th grade teams are phenomenal! We need to keep teams balanced so that class sizes aren't too large. It's complicated to schedule 750+ students into the classes they request. For these reasons, and lots of others, we cannot allow Team Requests. If you have a special circumstance, please contact your school counselor or administrator to discuss it.
- Open one 7th grade team have all of the accelerated students?
 - Nope! All 7th grade teams have a pretty even number of students that are taking Accelerated classes.

- There are no encore choices that I want for alternate choices, what should I do?
 - Try to pick some even if they're not your top choices! Leaving the Alternate choices blank will not ensure you are given your top choices. If you do not put any Alternate choices, we will put you in whatever class has the most space.
- O I was recommended for Quest, do I have to take the class?
 - Yes. Quest recommendations are based on AIR, and MAP scores, as well as teacher recommendations. Students are placed in Quest because test scores used for placement indicate that students are not on track to pass State Assessments, End of Course Exams, or receive college ready scores on ACT/SAT without intervention.



 Students will need to turn in a completed Course Selection
 Sheet with a parent signature, and any teacher initials needed for Advanced Courses.
