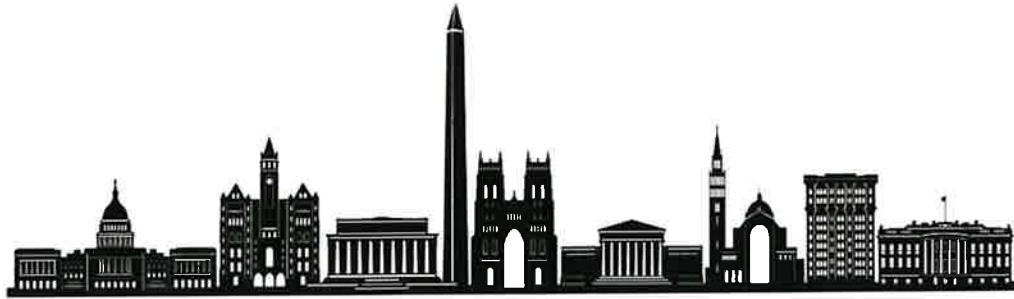


# **KJH 8th Grade Washington D.C. Trip**

## **Facts about the trip at a glance (details attached):**

- Travel dates: October 4–6, 2023 **(Trip ID: 15479A)**
- The trip includes stops to: Arlington National Cemetery, The Holocaust Museum, The White House, Smithsonian museums, Mount Vernon, and several national monuments
- Students will be accompanied by KJH staff chaperones at a 15:1 ratio (no parent chaperones permitted on the trip).
- Students are expected to maintain proper behavior and attendance both prior to travel as well as during the trip:
  - If a student cancels or is removed from the trip PRIOR to travel, refunds will be issued by Scholastica based on their refund policy (attached).
  - If a student is no longer allowed to participate due to misbehavior during the trip, the parents will be notified, the student will have to be picked up (at their own expense), and no refunds will be issued.
- All expenses are covered in the price of the trip– the only money needed would be for optional snacks and/or souvenirs (amount to be determined by each family).
- Students are not permitted to bring their own medication (either prescription or over the counter)-- medication forms must be filled out by the student's doctor and turned in to the KJH nurse PRIOR to travel. Medications will be held by the student's chaperone.
- Trip information will be posted on the school website after the meeting.

Calendar Days Before Scheduled Departure Date	Cancellation Policy
